

NSC 2026 STATE LEVEL – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Q : What is the minimum & maximum duration for the overall video?

A : There is no minimum duration however the video should not exceed the 3 minutes running time, including the 10 seconds title screen.

Q : What is needed in the title screen?

A : The 10-second 'title screen' must include:

- Team ID
- School name
- State
- Title of video

Q : What kind of content do we need in our video?

A : The video must demonstrate:

- The experiment conducted and how it addresses the problem statement
- The experimental setup and design
- The scientific explanation and methodology
- The results and conclusion of the experiment

Q : Can we mix the language to include both Bahasa Melayu and English in one video?

A : The video must be only in one language throughout, either Bahasa Melayu or English. The language used must be **consistent** with the language of the scientific report and vice versa.

Q : Where, when, and how should we submit the scientific report and video?

A : The scientific report and video can be submitted latest by **17 July 2026, 11.59 pm.**
